The visit will begin at the Ataria Interpretation Centre, an emblematic space where a presentation will be given on the Green Belt of Vitoria-Gasteiz, its origin, development, and role in urban sustainability. From there, participants will take part in a guided tour of the Salburua wetlands, a restored ecosystem of great ecological value within the Green Belt.
